Q | What is Design Support?

This is an additional tutorial given to those who do not have a design or drawing background or anyone who desires it. The fee covers one-on-one tutorial for 1 hour every week for four weeks.

## What is the 3d/AI software training about?

The purpose of this training is to bring all students to the same level of drawing skills from the beginning of the course. All students who are not proficient in a 3D modelling software are expected to register for the training in the 3D software. The software to be used is Coohom. The student will have to subscribe for this software personally. However, a highly discounted price is available through this program. Extra personal training support is available at an extra fee.

What is 'Make up tutorial & tests'?

Students who fail less than 2 modules are expected to receive tutorials and repeat the assignments and tests.

Who has to take the 'Tests for admission'?

Every student who does not have design/construction background would have to sit for a short online test prior to admission. There may also be other special instances where tests may need to be administered. Every applicant will be notified about this prior to the conclusion of the admission process. The purpose is to identify whether the candidate is qualified for admission and if so, the additional academic support which the candidate may need during the program.

### INSTALMENTS PAYMENT PLAN FAQS

## Q

## What is the Instalments Payment Plan

The Instalments Payment Plan allows a student to pay the semester's tuition and mandatory fees in three installments of 60%, 20% and 20%. In this payment plan, 60% of the semester's tuition and mandatory fees is due a day before resumption while the next installment of 20% is due 30 days after classes begin and the remaining 20% is due approximately 60 days into the semester.

## Who is eligible?

All admitted students are eligible for this Instalments payment plan. If a student does not pay full fees by the resumption deadline, it is assumed that the student is opting for the Instalments payment plan. The due dates for the payment of installments are as shown on the table of important dates.

## What is the cost?

If the Instalments payment plan option is selected, a \$50 fee is added to the first 60% instalment to offset administrative costs.

# What happens if I don't make installment payments as agreed?

Failure to make the installments as agreed will result in additional \$10 per day for a maximum of one week; after which the candidate may wish to apply for leave of absence or withdrawal.

## **Q** When are the installments due?

Normally, for each semester, the three installment payments are due a day before resumption, 30 days and 60 days into the semester, respectively.

# Am I required to wait until my installment is due to pay it?

No. You can make payment of the exact amount towards your next installment at any time before it is due
